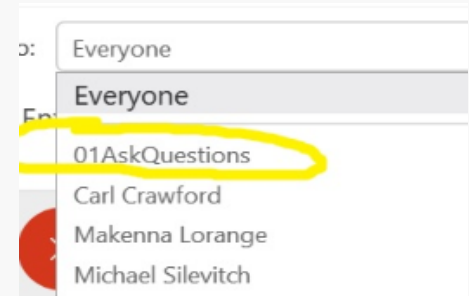
ADEPT03: So What? Who Cares?

- **Space: Custom and Border Protection (CBP)**
- **Problem: Speed of technology development and deployment**
- **Solution: Convene workshops**
 - Solution seekers to pose needs for enhanced technology
 - Technology providers state existence of solutions

- **Results:**
