Determining and Securing a Synagogue's Security Needs

- ASKT
 - Orthodox synagogue with 100 families; many opinions!
 - Services on site + external activities, many for children
 - Near busy roads, other synagogues and Jewish schools
- Security
 - Provided in part by Milwaukee Jewish Community (Ari Freidman's talk yesterday); DHS grants; security guards; training; CCTV
 - Highlighted awareness because of increase of anti-Semitic attacks worldwide
- Balancing Act
 - Guns
 - Rarity of events
 - Constrained by limited funds and need for open environment
 - Do not want to create fortress mentality
