Witness protection

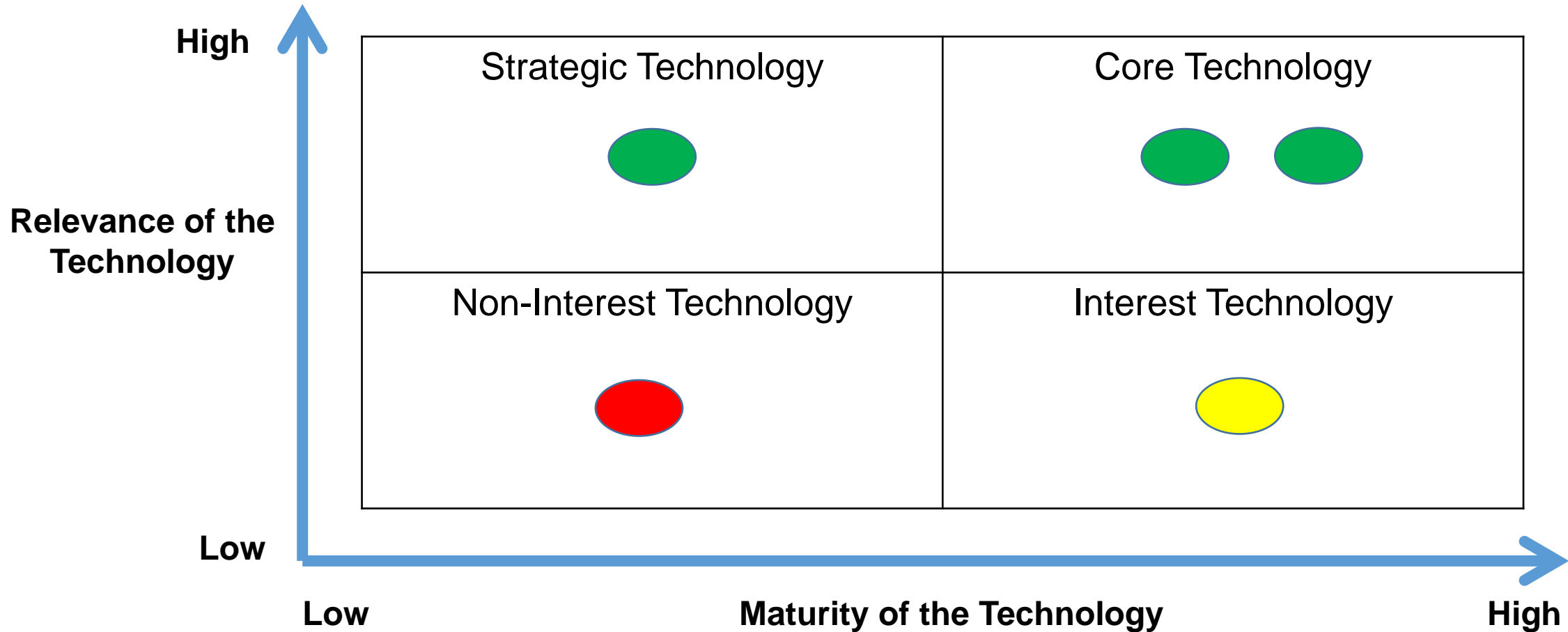

Controlling Urban Spaces

- Automatic detection of violence, disturbances and hazards
- Early alerts of natural disasters
- Alerting about violence and crime
- A unified control center, fusing information from various sources and integrating sensors



Public Disorder – Solutions

- Ability to neutralize aggressive, violent and dangerous people by use of non-lethal weapons
- Ability to manage large scale riots and public unrest
- Multifunctional armored vehicles for use in riots
- Alternatives to the Taser, featuring: Long distance, accurate targeting, that can temporarily disable an individual within a crowded area

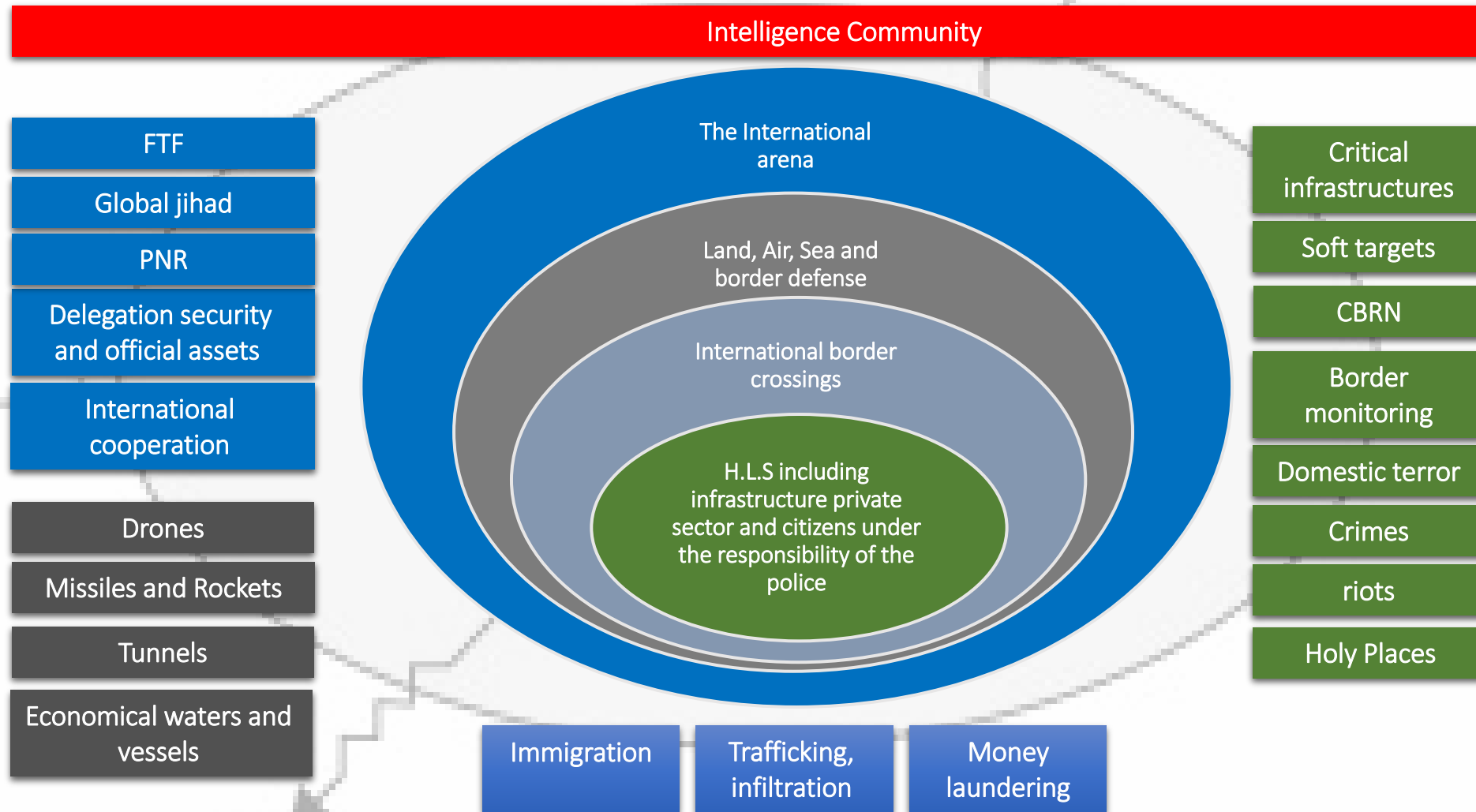


Security Checks

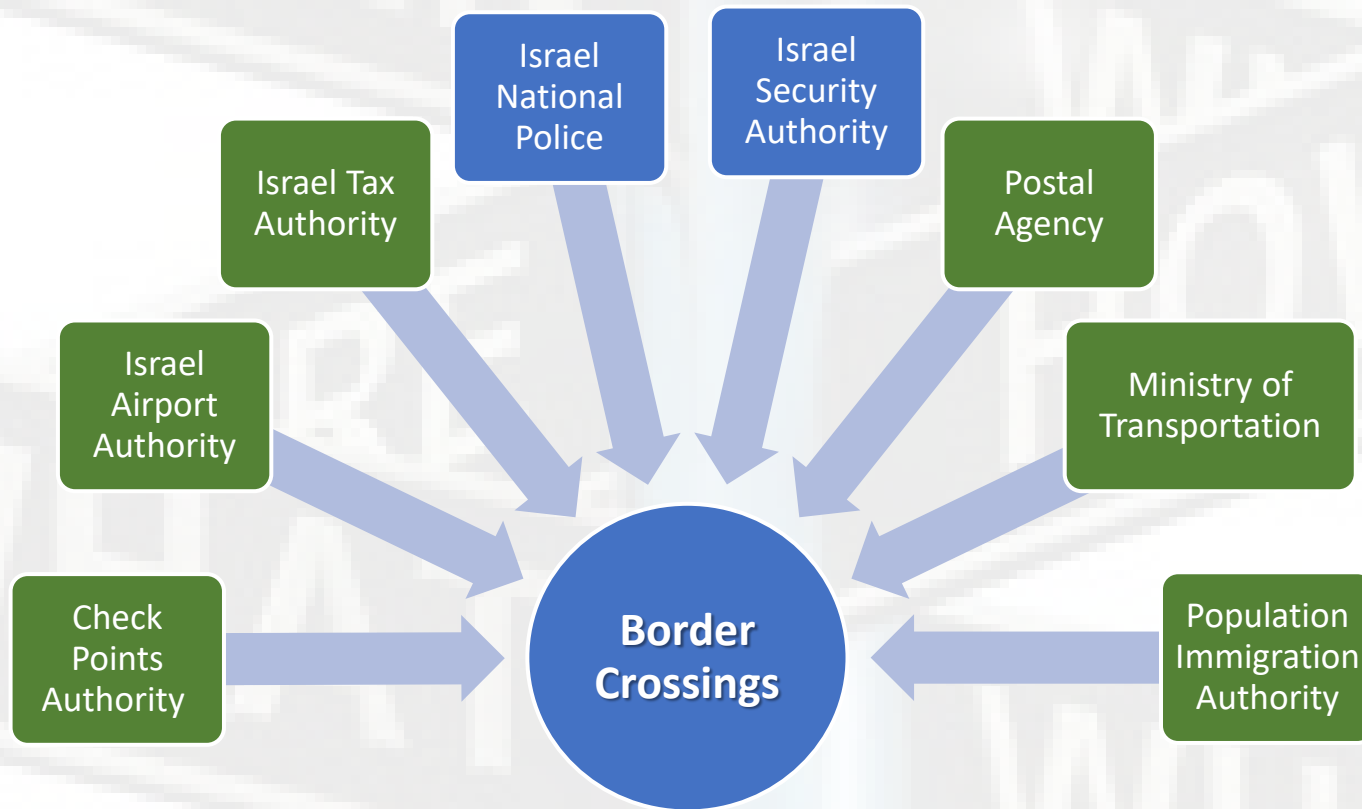
- Remote detection capability for a wide range of weapons on a person or his belongings
- Non-invasive detection allowing minimum disturbance and maximum flow capacity
- Handheld scent and vapor detection device for narcotics and explosives, including smuggled items within the body

- * **Cargo inspection systems with materiel discrimination**

- * **A.I for x-ray imaging**
- * **Use of video-analytics on border crossings to increase the trucks flow**
